April Book Report

Science Information Book (Non-fiction)

Choose a fun topic you'd like to learn about and then ask a librarian for help in finding a book about your topic. You may choose any scientific topic. It's fun to learn new things! There is no page requirement for your book, but please choose a book appropriate for 4th grade.

Part 1: Written report (see back side)

Part 2: Create a poster that displays the topic and information from your book. You will use this poster for part 3.

Part 3: Presentation. You will need to be prepared to stand by your poster and give information to each student who passes by you, in the style of a wax museum display. Each student who rotates to you will find you standing still like a doll. When a student pushes a button, you will come to life and give a fact about your book, and then stand still again. Be prepared to share 3 to 5 facts (about one minute). As there are 25 students, the class will be divided in half, so that half of the students are rotating around while the other half are giving information, then vice-versa.
